Local heritage :

St Sulpice church, typical of the French Vexin, listed historical monument (choir XIth century and bell XIIth century).

The City Hall was the jewelry pavilion during the Paris 1937 exhibition. Transferred and rebuilt, it was offered to the mayor of Seraincourt.

Général FRIANT's grave (Empire Count whose name figures on the arc de triomphe).



Famous people :

Ninon de LENCLOS (1620-1705) Courtesan, XVIIIth century writer.

Général FRIANT (1758 – 1829) General, empire count, Napoléon 1st 's chamberlain.

Pola NEGRI (1897 – 1987) Silent film actress

Did you know?

In 1555, Anne de Montmorency bought Vigny's castle. Her motto : Aplanos, which means « Without deviating ». You can still see it on the castle's pediment.



Local heritage :

Church Saint Médard neo-gothic style du XIXth century. You can visit it during Local heritage day.

Inside the church : organs by Louis Debierre built in 1896

Castle XVth century (Renaissance style troubadour).

Covered washing place, rue de la Comté (CD 169).

Cross, sundial, bread oven).

In the graveyard (rue Marie) : The Cenotaph dedicated to the princess of Rohan, the chapel of the count Vitali (1909), ossuary "ab antiquis" with the rest of the ancient graves of the former cemetery, Napoleon's last cooker grave

Amboise fountain, small cylindrical tower

Calvary

Former police station made in rocks (Tuboeuf XIXth century).

Stable, orangery, glasshouses

The village is crossed over by the Roman route « la chaussée Brunehaut », and also by « Londres - Paris ».



Famous people :

Sébastien VAILLANT (1669-1722) French botanist and doctor, born in Vigny.

Several famous people went at Vigny's castle :

Charles VII and king Louis XI in 1441.

The cardinal Georges II of Amboise who died in 1550.

Longuesse is an essential step on the cycling trail Avenue Verte London/Paris/London

Local heritage :

St Gildard church – listed historical monument (XIII /XVIth century)
Vigny Longuesse quarry - Sensitive natural space. Natural reserve.
Reveals the origin of the Paris basin. Ancient coral reef with many fossils and the richest fauna of molluscs of the Danien age- (- 65 millions years) in Europe
2 old washing places.
Several crosses including a Pattée cross typical of the Vexin called Croix d'Orléans

Did you know ?

The church Saint-Sulpice is the only one in the Vexin having a classical style, with Saint-Cyr-en-Arthies's church.



Local heritage:

Church Saint-Sulpice :

Dates back to the XVIIIth century. It replaced a structure from the XIIth century, which might have been damaged by a fire during the Hundred years war. The former church threatening to fall apart was destroyed and at this location was built the presbytery.

Harvest museum :

It was set up in the former farm Moutier in Petit-Mesnil hamlet. There is a remarkable collection of tools and agricultural engines.

Price :

- Adult : 4 €
- less than 15 years : 2 €

- School and adult groups (from 15 people) : 3 € per person

Local historical fact :

Jérôme Bertault's funeral engraved plaque, who died in 1714. This plaque was discovered in 2004 and was replaced in the church.
